The guidelines for eligibility and units of supervised independent courses are noted below.

- **SL 298. Special Study for Graduate Students. (2-8 units)** *May be taken Letter Graded or S/U.* (3 units required if course is to count toward the Research Paper requirement for Ph.D. degree). Preliminary exploration of a restricted field involving research and requiring a written report. Two units of 298 will be included on graduate study lists for: audited classes if the student attends regularly and writes a short paper; upper-division (100 level) classes where additional written work and consultations with the instructor are required; Research Assistants whose tasks involve research learning experiences.
- **SL 299. Dissertation Writing.** (2-12 units) *Must be taken S/U.* Post advancement to candidacy units reserved for students directly engaged in doctoral dissertation research and writing. Course may be repeated for credit.
- **SL 310.** Internship in the Teaching of Literature/Linguistics. (1-2 units) *Must be taken S/U*. One 2-hour conference per week. Weekly meetings with the instructor/supervisor. Discussion of course aims, syllabus preparation, lecture and assignment planning, grading, and related matters. Students may prepare a representative portion of the work for such a course (e.g., lecture outline and assignments for a course segment) and may participate in presentation of the material and in evaluation of samples of student work.
- **SL 601/602.** Individual Study for Master's/Doctoral Exams. (2-8 units) *Must be taken S/U*. Preparation for MA or PhD comprehensive (or in some cases, language) <u>examination</u>. Units do not meet unit or residence requirements for the MA or Ph.D. program however they do count toward minimum units per semester required by the registrar. Maximum of 8 units per semester; no student may accumulate more than a total of 16 units of 600-series courses.
